

BD6Né Film Festival 2014
Regulations – 2nd edition
04 - 06th April, 2014



1. The short film competition BD6Né Festival 2014 is opened to any natural or legal person, regardless of age. There is no entry fee.
2. Films must realize an attachment or a bridge between cinema and comics, or graphic novels.
3. This competition is opened to any French or international short film with a running time of less than 20 minutes (including credits), completed after December 31th, 2011.
4. If the spoken dialogs of the film are not in French, short film must have French subtitles.
5. The registration deadline is February 28th, 2014.
6. Three ways for the registration :
 - the entry form must be printed, signed and sent with 1 DVD to the following address:

7. Registration will take effect once the DVD or video link part of the film received, accompanied by his registration form (completed and signed). A confirmation receipt will be sent to the sender by mail.

Special conditions relating to underage participants :



Any participation of a minor in the competition implies the prior consent of the person having parental authority over the minor, in which it is particularly clear that the authorization and data covers the rights which, directly or indirectly, are operations necessary for the film (screenings, TV, Internet, newspapers) and declares to have full knowledge of this Regulation. This agreement shall be in writing and attached to the entry form referred to in Article 6 and 7.

Special conditions relating to college students and high school:

A certificate of attendance will be provided for students in middle and high school, accompanying the entry addressed to the festival.

8. The films will be submitted to a selection test. The selection committee will view the festival films from DVD media and video links sent upon registration of the films.

9. Unsuccessful candidates in the selection will be able to recover the DVD they sent to the organizer. Return costs will be at the expense of candidates.

10. The official selection will be announced at the latest March 17th, 2014.

11. Entrants shall grant to the Festival the full and unconditional right to reproduce images or clips or a maximum length of three minutes for promotional purposes in any print media, on tv channels or online, and the full screening right for the Festival's internal promotion.

12. As part of this short film competition, film distribution is royalty free. Participants in the festival yield without consideration for the duration of the competition, the right to broadcast the selected films.

13. The producer or director agrees that they are the proprietors of the musical, filmic or textual rights of the works included in the film. In the contrary event the festival will not be held responsible.

14. Selected films will be judged by a jury of six or seven people, including films and comics personalities.

15. The president of the jury will be announced in March 2014.

16. Prizes will be evaluated by the Coordination Team of the festival and will be awarded by the jury during deliberation behind closed doors. The prizes will be awarded at the closing night of the festival.
